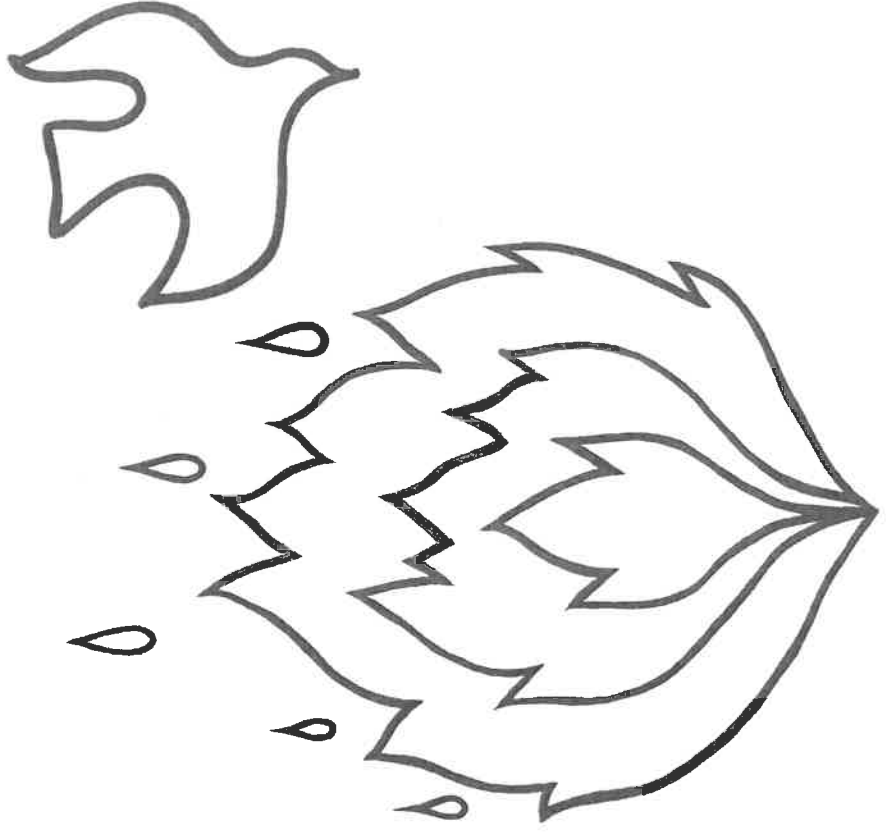
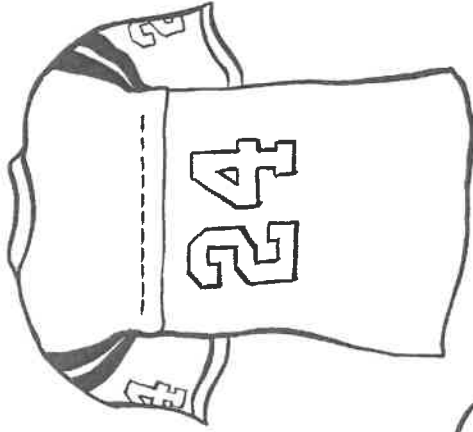
Look around! Can you find these red things at your church? When you find each one, color it red.

What else can you find that is red in your worship space?



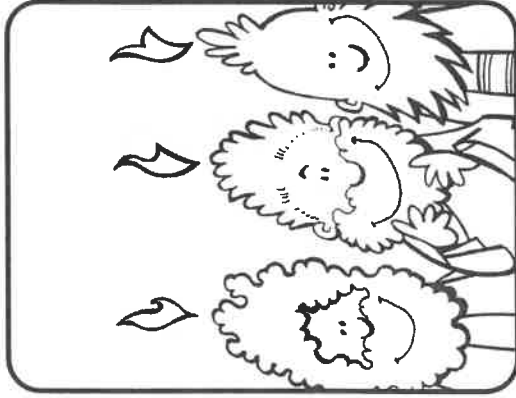
- Today is the **Day of Pentecost**.

Color these two symbols for Pentecost.

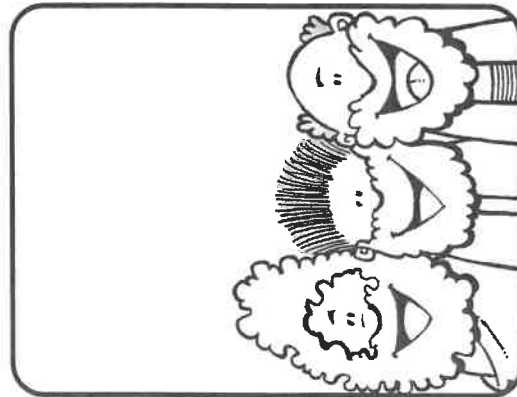




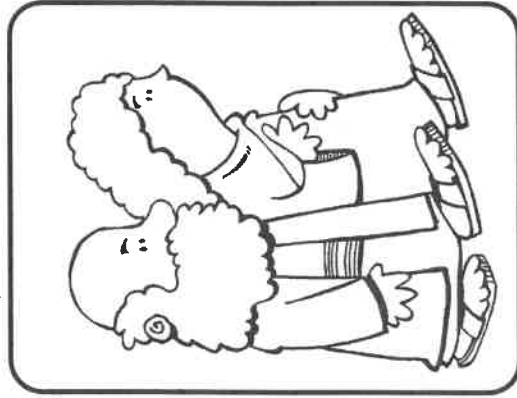
Suddenly a strong wind blew through the house.



It looked like each disciple had a flame of fire touching him, but no one was burned.

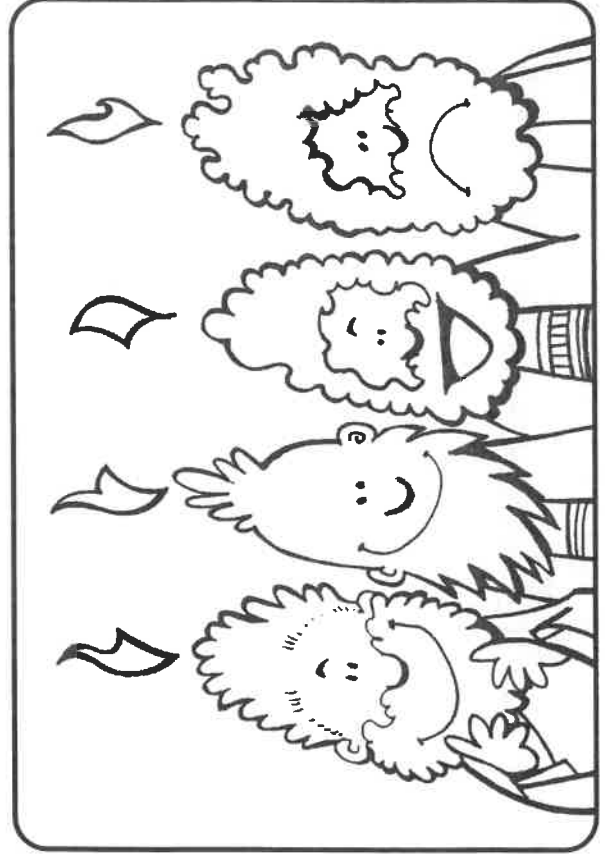
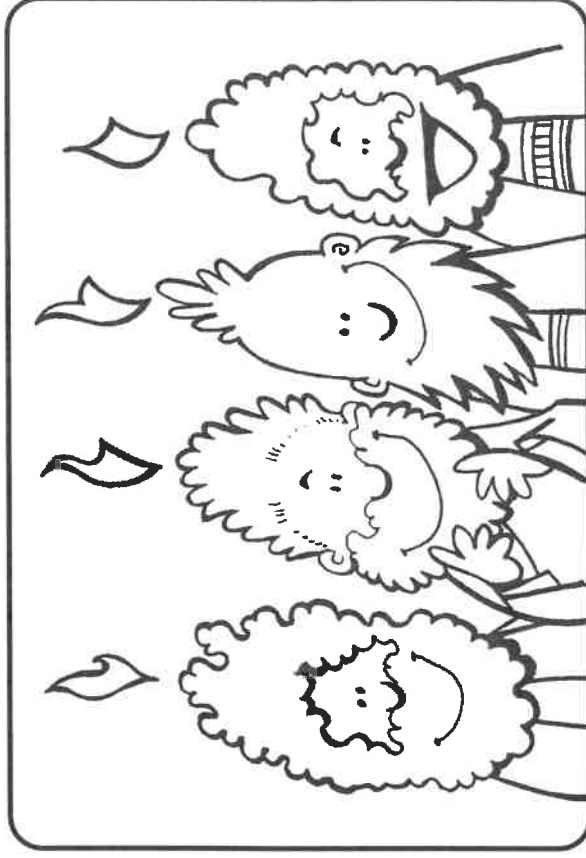


The disciples began to speak in different languages.

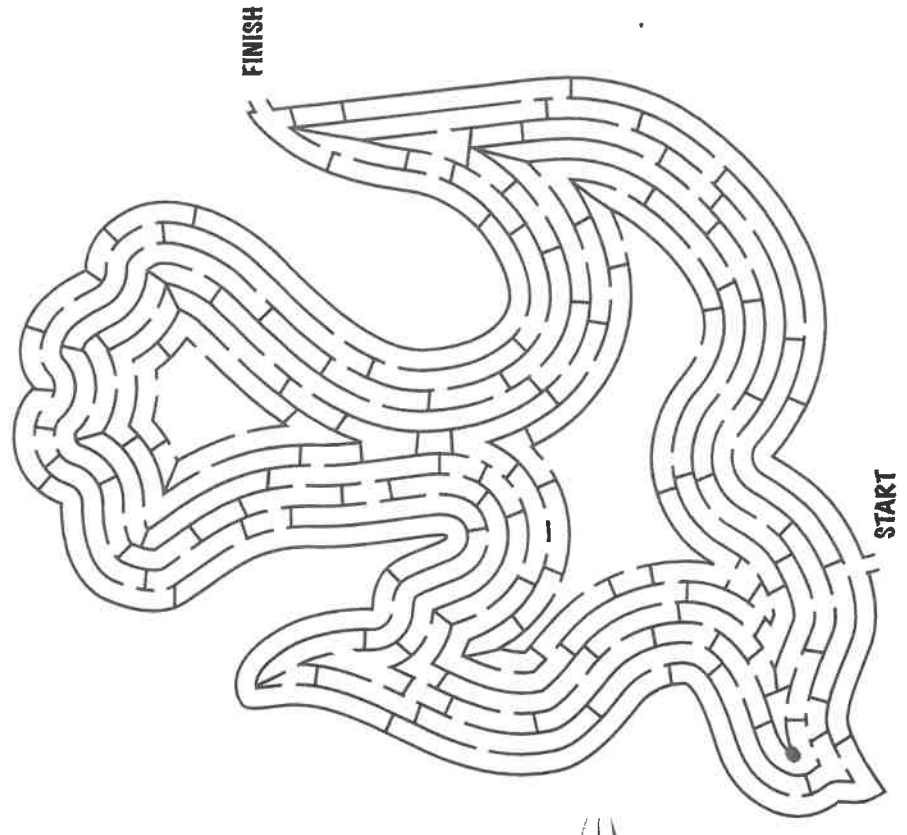
Day of Pentecost

- The color of Pentecost is **red**.

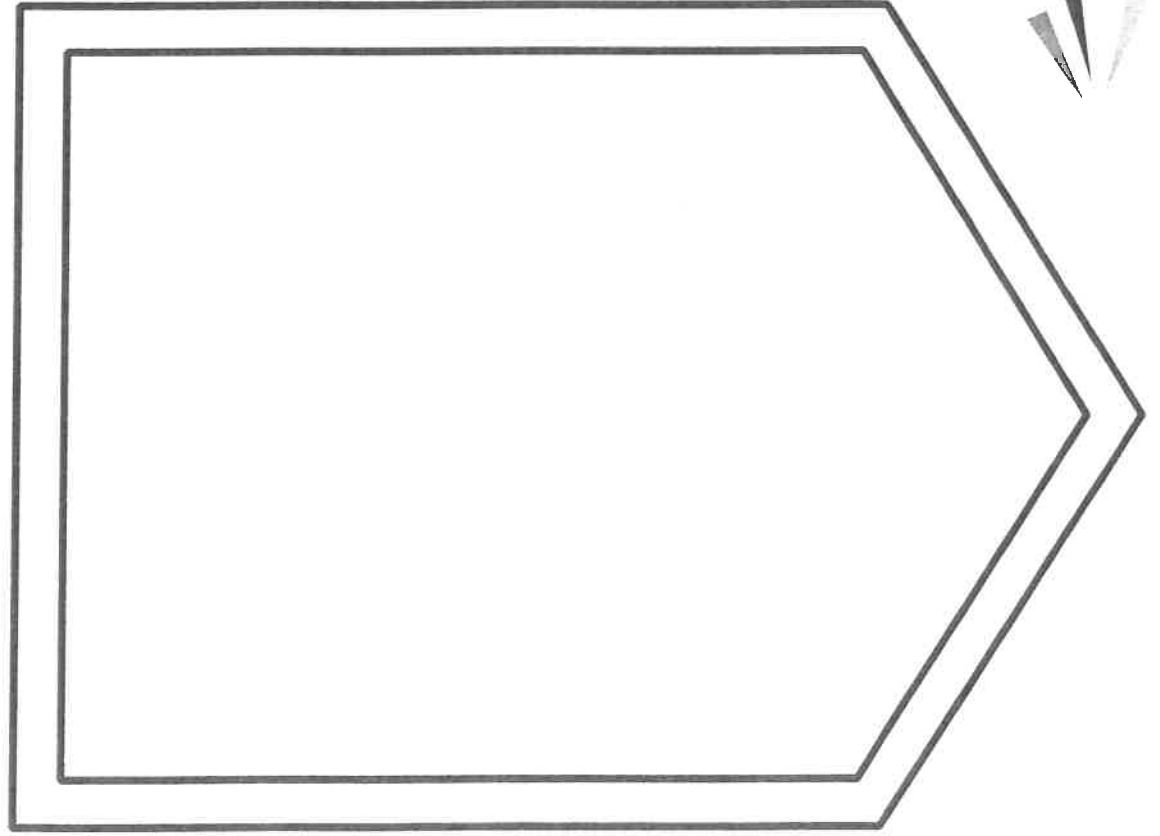
Flying to 50
