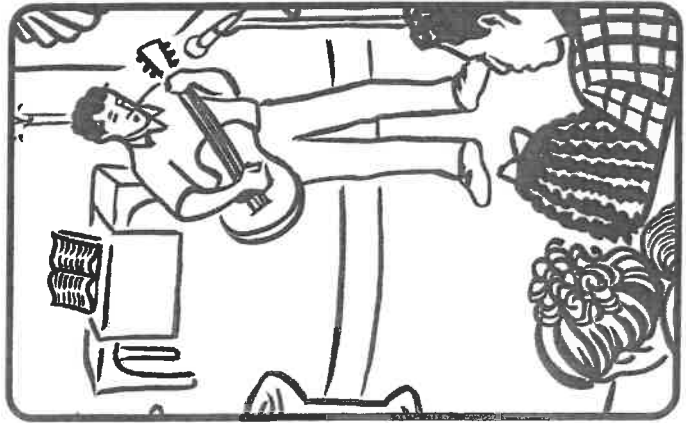
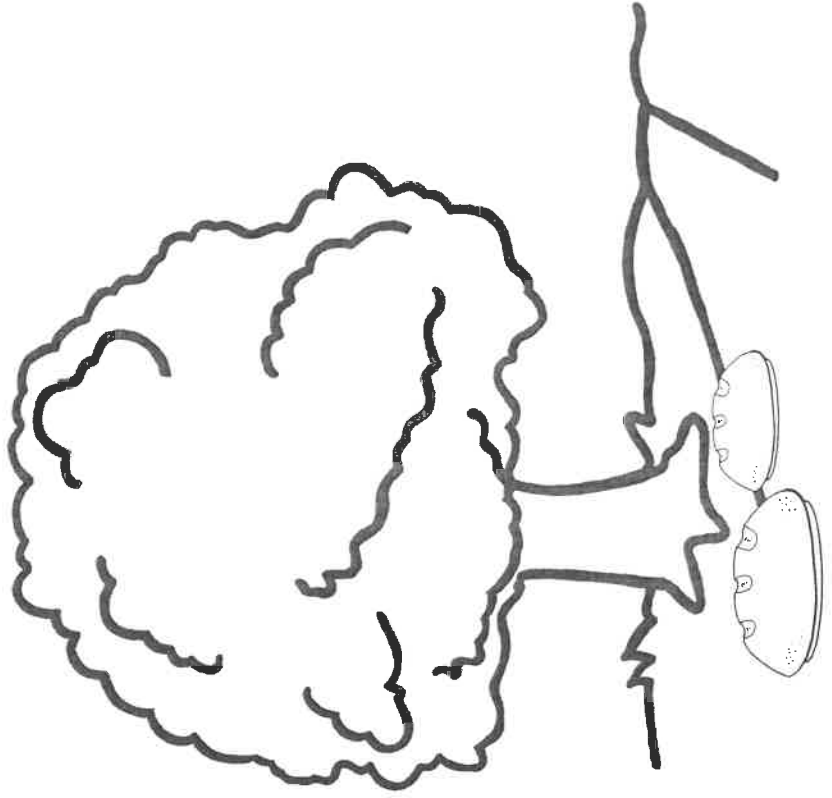


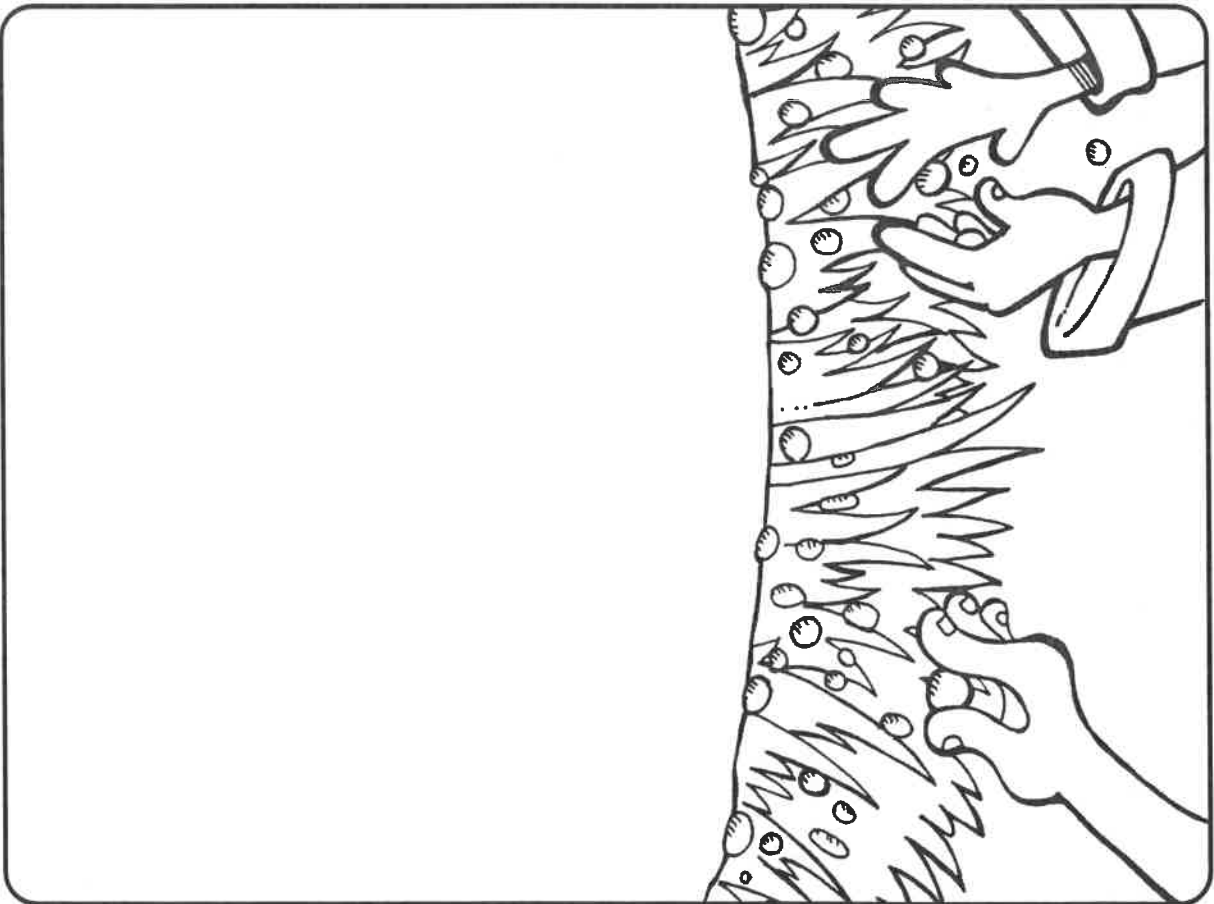
We all have jobs we can do at church.

What's in worship?

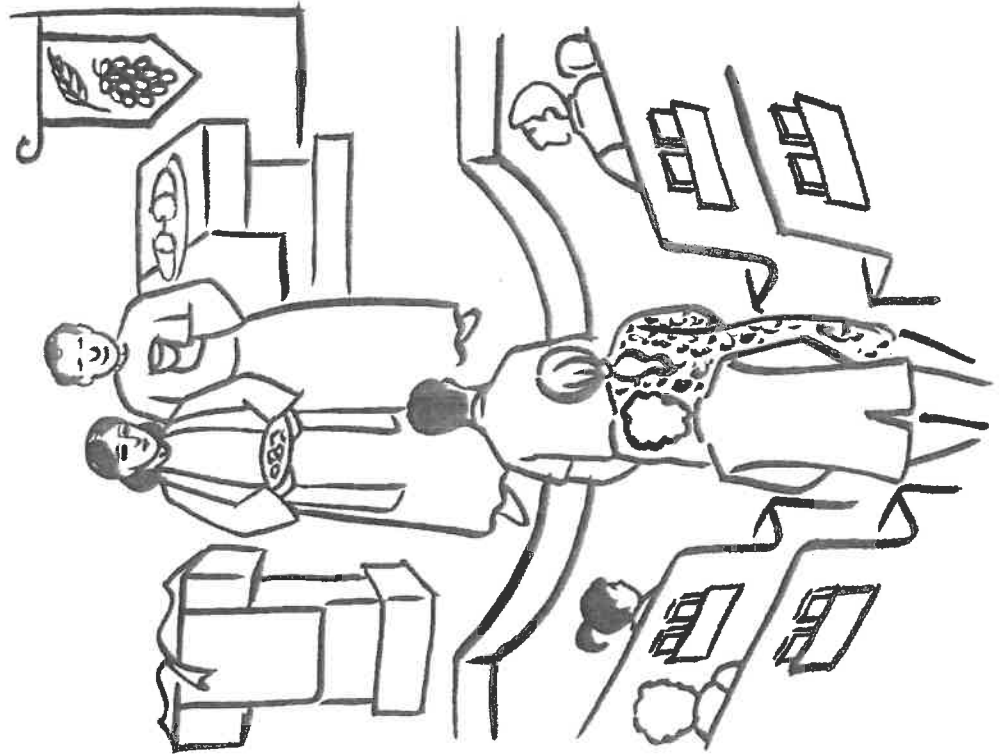
When we celebrate Holy Communion, we worship as one family of God. It is a celebrating time for all who are at worship. Find the following items and circle them.
