


# From Bible to Church






(Nunc Dimittis means "Now Dismiss")

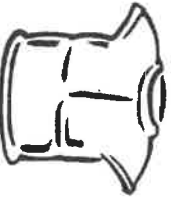

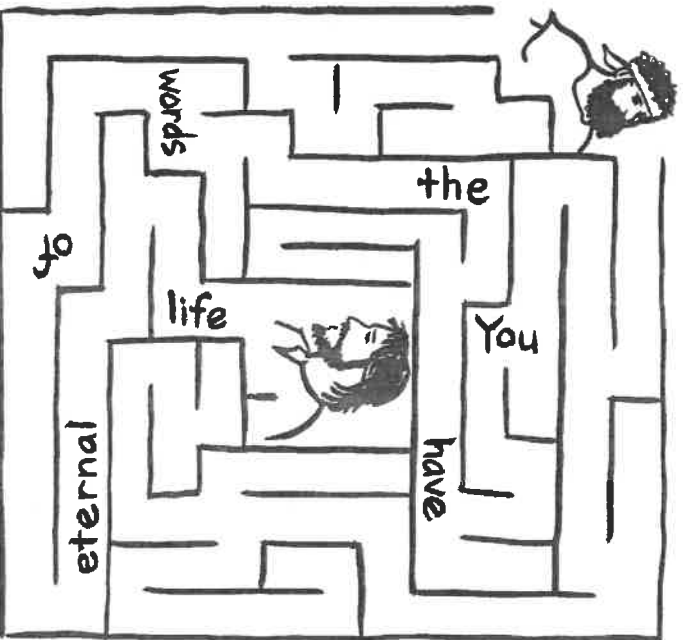

John begins his gospel by talking about the Word.

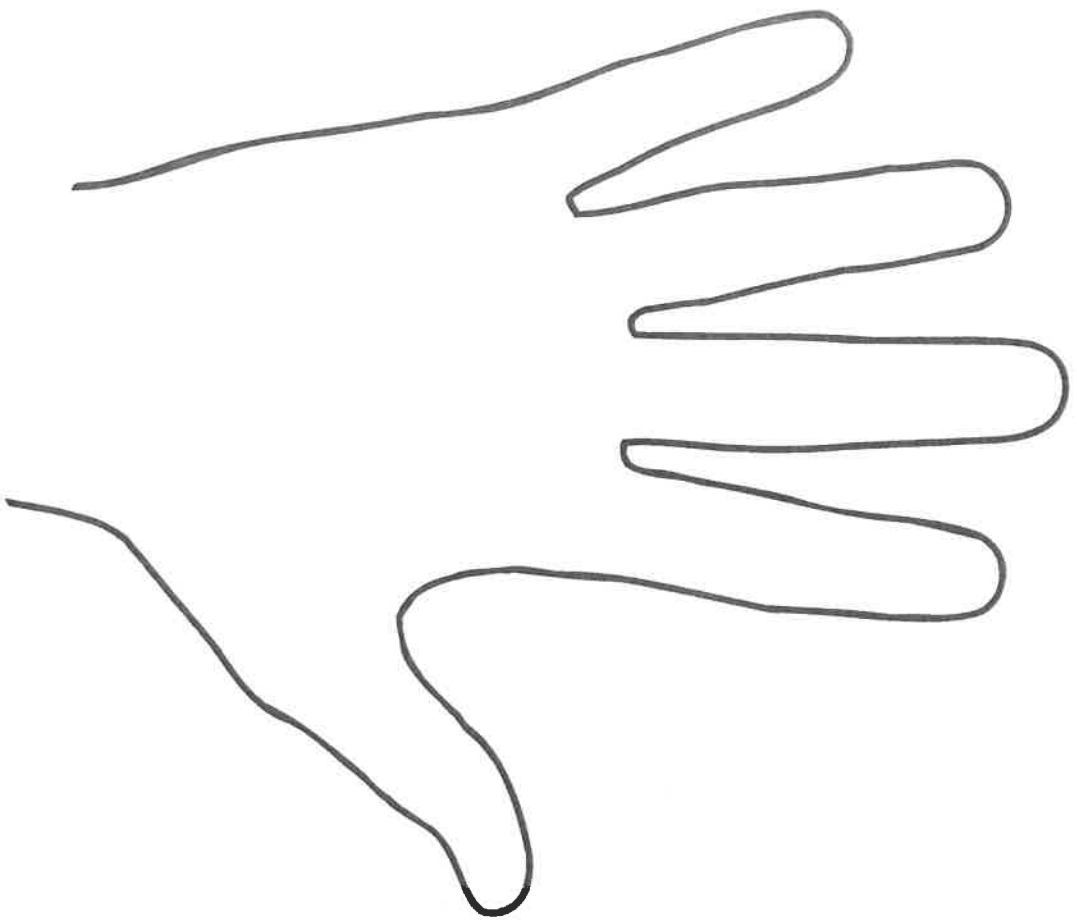

**When do you pray during worship? What do you do with your hands? Trace your praying hand inside this one.**



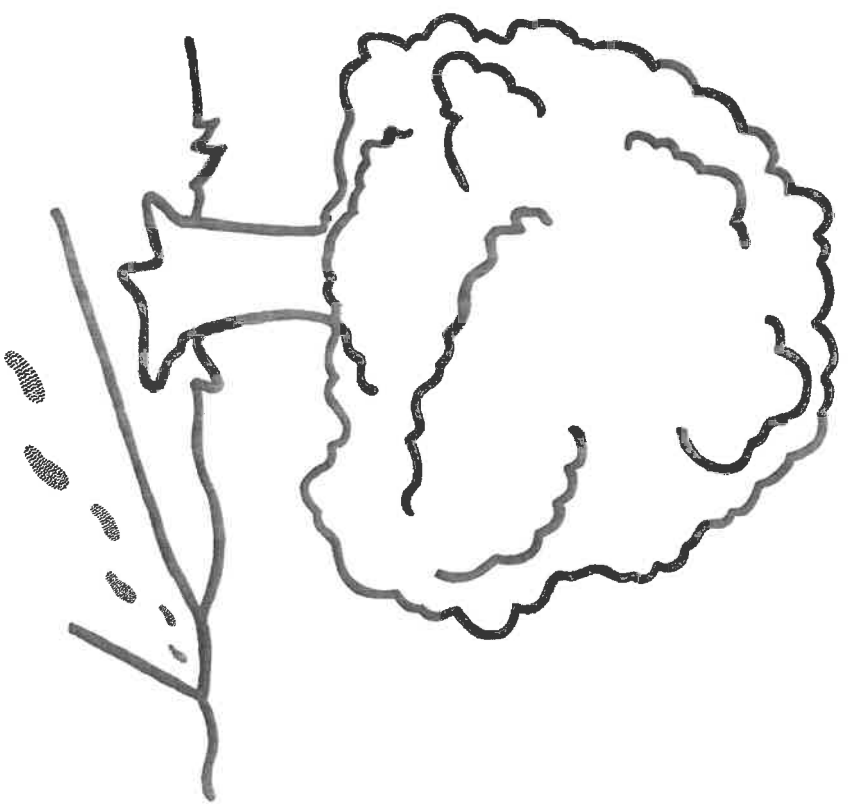

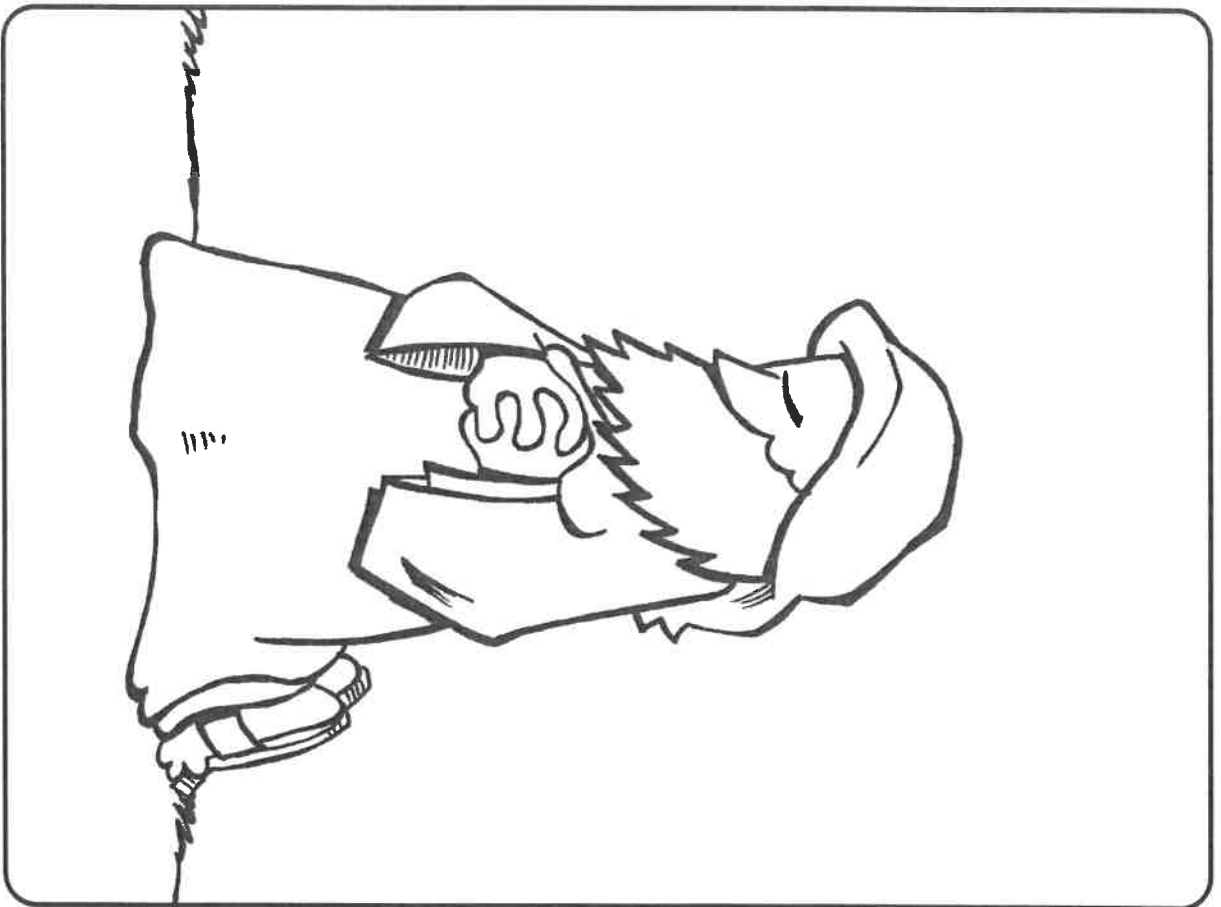

**Trace your shoe on top of this picture. You're a follower of Jesus!**

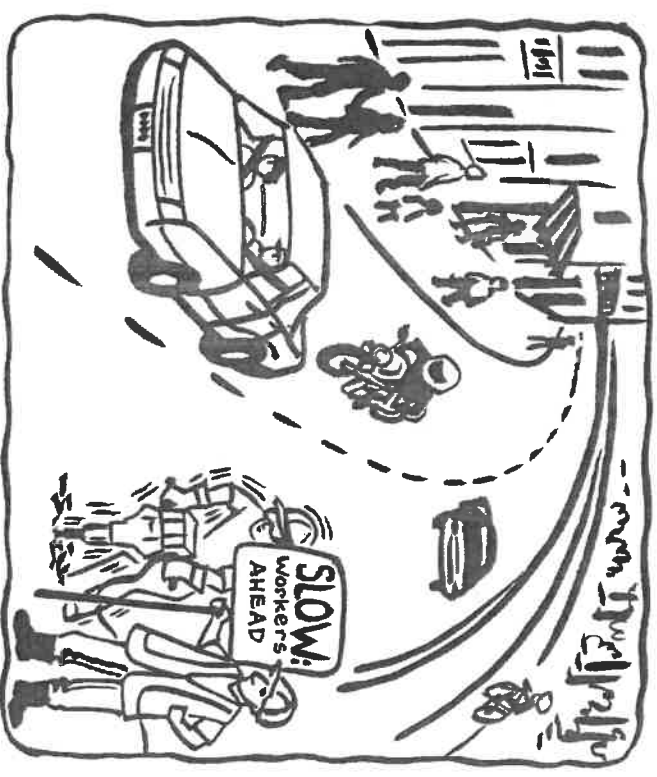


God is with us all the time. We are never alone. God is with us when things are dangerous.
